WE NEED YOU! We are currently looking for some volunteers to help run our school library. We would be grateful for as much or as little time you could offer. Some volunteers may wish to help tidy and replenish shelves, help to create eye catching displays and make the library a welcoming place to be, whilst others may feel confident enough to share a story with a class, make book recommendations or hold a book club.

If you are interested in volunteering in any capacity then we welcome you to contact the office (office.2609@ladygrove-park.oxon.sch.uk) or drop a note in at reception. Volunteers will be required to undertake a Disclosure and Barring Service check (DBS) along with providing two references. The possession of a criminal record will not necessarily prevent you from volunteering as all cases are judged individually according to the nature of the role and information provided.

FINAL REMINDER.....Letters went home to parents a few weeks ago about **flu vaccinations**. This is for children in Reception through to Year 5. This vaccination programme is taking place in school on Tuesday 13th November. Forms should have been returned no later than Wednesday 17th October. About 20% of parents have not returned their form and if forms are not returned your child will not be able to have this vaccine. If you have lost your form please ask for another one at the office.

The Travelling Book Fair returns to Ladygrove! During the week commencing Monday 26th November, the Travelling Books Book Fair will be open every morning and afternoon. We hope to have it in the courtyard again this year, unless it is terrible weather in which case we will relocate to the library. Reminder: Admissions to school (Academic Year 19/20): If your child was born between 1st September 2014 and 31st August 2015 you must apply for a school place for your child for entry in the academic year September 2018. You will be able to apply on-line from 25th October. Please visit www.oxfordshire.gov.uk/admissions for further information. The deadline line date is 15th January 2019.

Please remember the following:-

- It is the responsibility of parents/carers to apply for a school place by the deadline of 15 January 2019
- If your child is attending nursery classes within a primary school, you must still apply for a place in the main school
- You can list three different schools in order of preference. We strongly advise you to use all three preferences
- We advise you to enter your catchment (or designated) school as one of your preferences
- Attending your catchment school does not entitle you to free home to school transport if it is not your closest school and / under 2 miles away
- If your application is late, you are far less likely to get a place at one of your preferred schools.

Remember, to ensure your child transfers to the school that you consider most appropriate, you must apply before the closing date.
